- Program Update
  - Ruth Chrismore will take over the responsibilities of Program Director. She presented a tentative program calendar for board review. September through May, VGWC will host a monthly event. Events range from luncheons, fashion show, major fundraiser events and evening all VG community forums. A final program schedule will be available for final review at the August Board meeting and published to all members.

And we continue to have members volunteering regularly at The Neighborhood Center. We just launched a School Snack Drive for Summer School at Blue Lake Elementary.
- Finance Update May finance report was provided. After dues renewals, as of May 31, 2024 we have a balance of \$34,747.96 in the bank, \$8,006.58 temporarily restricted and earmarked for specific charities.
